

Rifle Camp Park – Woodland Park October 22nd (Saturday) -- Meet @ 3:30PM

3.3 miles Loop - EASY - Sits on the ridgeline of Garret Mountain, a section of First Watchung Mountain. The area of Rifle Camp Park served as a location where Washington's troops could observe British movements during the Revolutionary War in 1780. The name 'Rifle Camp' comes from the fact that Major James Parr's rifle corps camped for a short time in the vicinity of the Great Notch, just to the south of what would eventually become the park





Bring: Hiking Boots, Rain/Snow Gear, Hiking Backpack - 6 Essentials

(Flashlight, Filled Water Bottle, Whistle, First Aid Kit, Sun Protection, Trail Food)

Directions & Parking: 385 Rifle Camp Road, Woodland Park, NJ

Just beyond the entrance to "The Franklin Group/Mountain Ridge Tower," turn left into Rifle Camp Park. Continue along the park entrance road for 0.8 mile to its end at a circle, where parking is available.
